Rutland Memorial Hospital Clinics

- Project is co-ordinated by Rise MDT Neighbourhood Facilitator
- Patients will be invited to the anticipatory Clinic, where they can access a range of health specialisms and wider services. Carers will be invited to a follow-up event, tailored to needs of carers. Team members in the clinics include:
 - Rutland PCN Care Coordinator
 - Admiral Nurses
 - RISE representatives
- With the return of the Memory Clinic to Rutland Memorial Hospital, clinics for identified patients will be held alongside the Rutland focused Thursday sessions.
- Working collaboratively with LPT and the Memory Clinic to include information regarding the services available on the day. Other communications in development include:
 - Leaflet/s that include descriptions of services and contact information so patients can contact the necessary members after the session.
 - An A5 flyer to be sent to those 288 individuals proactively identified through the PCN, inviting them to the clinics.
- Clinics to begin on 12th July 2023

Joining up the Project with the Research

- Healthwatch Rutland have recently published their Dementia report.
- The project team will be working closely with Healthwatch Rutland to plan next steps to:
 - Map what gaps are closed with the project.
 - Identify the gaps that remain for further consideration by the IDG
- First meeting with Healthwatch to be held in July, with the Dementia research being brought to the Health & Wellbeing Board in August.
