GCSE - Content

- Either reflect the fact that the religious traditions of Great Britain are in the main Christian, whilst taking into account the teaching and practices of other principal religions represented in Great Britain (in which case students must not be required to study more than two principal religions in addition to Christianity)
- Or support the study of Christianity and/or one or two other principal religions only.
