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### 1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

- 1.1 To update the Peoples (Children's) Scrutiny Panel on the current status of the Risk Register.

### 2. RECOMMENDATIONS

### 3 BACKGROUND

- 3.1 The Corporate Risk Register is normally presented to the Audit and Risk Committee on a quarterly basis. The Committee last received an update on the 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2013.
- 3.2 It was agreed at the Scrutiny Commission meeting that the Risk Register would also now be reported to Scrutiny Panels for review and discussion of risks relevant to their remit.
- 3.3 The risks relevant to the Peoples (Children's) Scrutiny Panel are in section one and two of Appendix A.
- 3.4 A summary of the risks, plotted on the risk matrix has been prepared. This is shown as Appendix B and highlights how the risks are spread across the matrix.
