## **UPDATE ON THE LITTLE BUILD**

### 1. BACKGROUND

The Better Schools for All Strategy was approved by Cabinet and Council in Summer 2008 with DCSF approval in November 2008 releasing total grant funding of £ 12.9m, some of which has to be spent by 31<sup>st</sup> August 2011.

a. The Little Build is the project to rebuild Oakham Church of England Primary School within the allocated budget of £7.583,148

## 2. VISION

In June 2009, approval of a 'soft federation' of The Parks Schools and Oakham CofE Primary extended the project to include a rebuild of The Parks, The Family Centre and a small therapy/learner pool.

## 3. PLANNING APPLICATION

The Planning Application was approved on 27 Apr 2010.

The only change imposed was the closure of the pedestrian entrance from Queens Rd.

### 4. DESIGN

- a. A Core Design Group representing the two Schools, Capital Projects, Architects and Constructors developed the outline design for the site and building layout.
- b. The Core Design Group continues to meet to finalise interior and exterior finishes and operational details..

## 5. FUNDING

- a. A reduction in the Targeted Capital Fund grant was notified to RCC just prior to contract agreement, reducing the available funding to £7,454,848. This required some Value Engineering to effect a reduction in Contracted Target Price to £6,575,284.
- b. Contract with Willmott Dixon was signed by RCC 29 July

### 6. CONSTRUCTION

- a. Site pre-works were completed during July 2010. This comprised the installation of 3 temporary classrooms and relocation of the existing SEN mobile unit. Teachers fitted-out their classrooms during the holidays, ready for pupils to start the new school year in them.
- b. Full construction commenced on 11 Aug 2010 with the demolition of the single-storey wing adjoining the Hall.
- c. Main construction is well underway and will be done in 3 closely-successive phases.
  - Foundation-wing base has been concreted and timber frame is being erected
  - Main Hall section base has been concreted, timber frame will follow during October
  - Teaching-wing base has been levelled, concreting will be done during October with timber frame to follow.
- d. Completion of the new building is on-schedule for July 2011, so that fit-out and commissioning will be completed ready for occupation at the start of Sept 2011 term. The temporary classrooms will be removed during the July/Aug 2011 holiday, allowing work on the carpark to commence
- e. Demolition of the existing school will take place Sept /Oct 2011, followed by completion of car park and landscaping on the original school site.
