Report of the Interim Strategic Director for Resources

STRATEGIC AIM: All

1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1.1 To present the current risk register to the Committee.

2. RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 That the Committee notes the contents of the risk register and the actions underway to address the risks.

3. REASONS FOR THE RECOMMENDATIONS

3.1 To provide the Committee with assurance that the strategic risks are being adequately managed.

4. UPDATED POSITION

- 4.1 The Committee last received an update on 25th September 2012. Since then the risk register has been kept under review and the risk ratings reaffirmed by Strategic Management Team. The register is attached at **Appendix A**.
- 4.2 A summary of the risks, plotted on the risk matrix has been prepared. This is shown at **Appendix B** and highlights how the risks are spread across the matrix.
- 4.3 During the meeting of 25th September 2012 it was recommended that a new Risk be added (minute 386), because of concerns raised over the retention of senior staff and subsequent recruitment of replacements due to the increase in accusations made against officers. This has now been added as Risk S.27.
- 4.4 There are three further new risks added. These are:
 - Risk S. 25 Local Sustainable Transport Bid.
 - Risk S. 26 Cellar Collapse.
 - Risk S. 28 Housing Stock Transfer Warranties and Residual Environmental Liabilities.

Further information on each of these risks is included in **Appendix A**.
