1	Councillor G Waller	Councillor R Powell, Deputy Leader and Portfolio Holder for Planning, Highways and Transport	The planning for the Stamford North development is well advanced and a planning application has been submitted for the part of the development within Rutland at Quarry Farm. However, it appears that neither the part of the site within Rutland nor that within Stamford includes provision for a medical practice. Can the Portfolio Holder please tell us whether discussions with South Kesteven District Council and/or Allison Homes to include a medical practice building being built as part of the developer contributions for Stamford North?
2	Councillor P Browne	Councillor S Harvey, Portfolio Holder for Health, Wellbeing and Adult Care	Difficulties in accessing GPs have been a concern of many Rutland residents for some time and the numbers of Rutland residents leaving Lakeside Healthcare in Stamford to join Empingham Medical Practice has added to the pressure on GP services locally. With regard to the proposed Stamford North development, can the Portfolio Holder detail the discussions she has had with both the Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland Integrated Care Board and its Lincolnshire equivalent to fund a GP practice on the Stamford North site should a building be provided through developer contribution?
