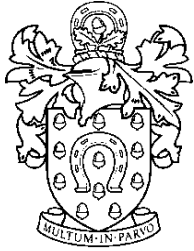

Date of Committee Meeting	23 rd March 2023
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Recommendations:

- 1) To provide clarity to members at Council on Monday evening around the transformation project and the potential change in services resulting in the investment of the LUF and that benefits will be brought forward accordingly.
- 2) That the Economic Strategy Task and Finish Group be involved in reviewing the new Baseline calculations, timelines and the GO/NO-GO gateways potentially involving Cabinet decisions.
- 3) That the Transformation Governance Meeting involving Group Leaders be tasked with reviewing the savings achieved by the capital expenditure under 1 above.
- 4) To provide clarity to members at Council on Monday evening of the potential of extending the scope of the LUF to provide wider and deeper health provision in Oakham.
- 5) Suggest that Scrutiny Committee consider the LUF Project Board Terms of Reference when it comes to Cabinet later this year in order to consider the implications of whether it should be considered as a Very High Risk project requiring Council approval rather than a High Risk project.
- 6) To consider a member visit to a Medi-Hub, similar in style to that proposed, to understand the concept and the opportunities.

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
