Bus Stop Improvements 2019

PURPOSE OF THE DECISION

To allocate capital funding to carry out bus stop improvements as supported by the Highways and Transport Working Group on 4th June 2019. Total capital funding of £44,250.

DECISION DETAIL

Improvements discussed with portfolio holder and other members of Highways and Transport working group on 4th June 2019.

Specific bus stop improvements are:

Leicester Road, Uppingham – £8k New Road, Clipsham – £2k Rogues Ln, Kendrew Barracks – £20k Main Street, Greetham – £10k High Street, Oakham - £500 Bus stop equipment - £3750

REASON FOR THE DECISION

To enable improvement / replacement / construction of public transport infrastructure.

OTHER OPTIONS CONSIDERED AND REJECTED

To not improve / replace / construct public transport infrastructure. This is likely to incur increased costs in the long term and reduce customer satisfaction.
