Issues to be highlighted to Council

The Rural Community Council was established in 1924 with a fundamental aim of supporting rural communities across Leicestershire and Rutland. Its mission over the last 99 years has evolved to suit the times in which we live. As RCC approaches its centenary in 2024, it aims to take simple but effective action for people and organisations in Leicestershire and Rutland facing issues such as loneliness, isolation, poor mental wellbeing, suicide, unemployment, deprivation and the decline of valuable rural services and amenities.
