A number of emails have been communicated with staff at Rutland Water, in relation to the out of date Countryside For All leaflets on their web site. It was a member of their staff that informed us that Rutland Water staff had carried out surveys during the pandemic with the aim of updating the current two leaflets and creating other Countryside For All leaflets.

Unfortunately Anglian Water have stated they will not be able to fund the reprinting of the leaflets at the moment. I feel that they need to update the leaflets in terms of accessibility prior to printing. Looking at their new web site both leaflets have now been removed.
